1. Four (4) good quality photos of the entered tractor are required along with entry blank. Photos should be 1 front, 1 rear and one of each side of your tractor. Quality photos matter.
2. Clarity of the photos is very important. Photos must be in color.

IF YOU ARE CHOSEN AS A FINALIST

1. Top five (5) finalists will be asked to have their selected tractors on display at the Missouri Livestock Symposium on the following dates and hours: Friday, December 2, 2011, 2 p.m. until 10 p.m. and Saturday, December 3, 2011, 8 a.m. until 5 p.m.
2. The location of the Missouri Livestock Symposium is the Kirksville Middle School, 1515 S. Cottage Grove, Kirksville, MO.
3. Applications submitted indicate entrant is willing to display tractor.
4. In the event of bad weather, the Missouri Livestock Symposium will notify finalists if displays will be waived.
5. Liability for tractors on display at the Missouri Livestock Symposium will be the sole responsibility of the owner(s) or their agents(s). The Missouri Livestock Symposium will provide a locked lot for housing of tractors overnight while at the Symposium, if desired. A security guard will be on duty when the Symposium is not open.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. The ten (10) semi-finalists' entries will be chosen by the selection committee. The top 10 selected will be voted on online as indicated in #2 below.
2. Online voting on the KTVO website at <http://www.heartlandconnection.com/> will start November 21, 2011 at 8 a.m. and conclude November 27, 2011 at 5 p.m.
3. The top 5 tractors receiving the most votes from the online voting will be notified as to their selection and details about displaying their tractor at the Missouri Livestock Symposium for final judging.
4. The winner will be selected by a committee representing the Missouri Livestock Symposium and KTVO.
5. Those entering classic tractors hereby authorize the use and display of all submitted photos and accompanying stories by the Missouri Livestock Symposium and KTVO.
6. More than one (1) tractor may be entered per person or entity.

AWARDS

1. The top 5 finalist will receive \$75.00 each and a plaque. The winner will receive a trophy and an award package from Orscheln's.
