**Scholarship Award and Details:** Successful scholarship applicants will be awarded \$200 to offset their expenses to attend this training course, regardless of their place of residence. Successful applicants will also receive approximately \$100 in sheep and meat goat resource materials. Those awarded scholarships will be expected to attend the Missouri Livestock Symposium on Saturday, December 3 as part of this training package. Free meals are provided for participants as follows - free dinner on Friday night, December 2; free breakfast and free lunch on Saturday, December 3. There will be no registration fees or pre-registration requirements for the Saturday Missouri Livestock Symposium portion of the program.
